Problem



- More and less developed NRENs
 - New technologies
 - New services
 - Reorganisation and staff turnover
 - Challenging projects (<u>E@P.connect</u>)

.... require constant efforts in order to transfer & upgrade competencies

NRENs are "breaking already opened doors", due to low knowledge exchange in community.

Campus Best Practices is virtually the only knowledge transfer programme in GEANT, yet it was mainly focused on creating written recommendations.

What's in demand (survey)




- NOC operations & cooperation (GEANT-wise)
- Broadband technologies
- Security, security
- Cloud services
- Implementation of GEANT services (envelope model)
 - Edugain best practices, services behind it (what does edugain enable?)
 - Educonf lack of coherent vision and best practices
 - How to sell GEANT services to users

Achievements so far (EaP countries, GN3Plus)




- Three workshops executed, 70 people participated, 12 days of training
- Training statistics for CBP:

% of people trained in CBP events (compared to total GEANT training received)



% of CBP events (compared to total # of GEANT training events attended)



Proposal for GN4Y1



- To introduce the "interactive knowledge transfer component" in CBP
- Training not only concentrated on Campus, but also core
- CBP probably the only "general purpose" training activity in GN4Y1
 - Lots of intensive hands-on required
 - Focus southeastern Europe

Challenges:

- Short time, lot of demands
- Hands-on require intensive preparation and infrastructure
- Good tutors from GEANT community or hire external?
